

Veteran Summer Registration

When planning your schedule remember that the VA doesn't look at how many hours you take during a semester. **They focus on the start and end dates of each class and how long those classes run.** As soon as a class ends or begins they reevaluate your course load and adjust your benefit rate. For example, if you take all of your classes during summer I and do not register for any classes during summer II, no matter how many credit hours you take, you will only receive benefits for summer I.

What is Full-Time?

8 week classes-6 credit hours

15 week classes-12 credits

When sessions overlap the VA will calculate your rate of pursuit.

Post 9/11 Chapter 33 Students

VA calculates rate of pursuit by dividing the number of credit (or credit hour equivalents) being pursued by the number of credit considered to be full-time by the school. The resulting percentage is the student's rate of pursuit.

RATE OF PURSUIT MUST BE OVER 50% for students to be entitled to any of their housing benefit.

Examples: **If full-time is 6credits, then rate of pursuit for:**

- 3 credits is 50% ($3 \div 6 = 50\%$) Student **is not** entitled to any housing benefits
- 4 credits is 67% ($4 \div 6 = 67\%$) Student **is** entitled to partial housing benefits

Don't forget to submit your Statement of Intent as soon as you register for classes!
