

## Student Ambassador Applications Now Being Accepted.

### Fall/Winter 2017-2018

A Student Ambassador is a current OCC student that has completed a minimum of 12 credit hours at OCC (at the time of application) and has a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher.

Ambassadors work 60 hours **per semester**, for both the fall and winter, (a total of 120 hours) in the following areas:

- Staffing the welcome areas and canvassing campus during Welcome Week
- Providing campus tours for visitors
- Representing the College at campus events
- Working with faculty and staff to promote and support campus activities

**You must be a student and willing to work during both the fall and winter semesters to apply.**

Student Ambassadors reach out to current students and make them aware of the programs and services available through OCC. They support all campus and some College activities. In exchange for their service, ambassadors receive excellent resume building leadership training and experience, a letter of appreciation from the campus president (great for a career portfolio), and a \$500 OCC scholarship, **per semester**, for a total scholarship of \$1,000.

Student Ambassadors will need to be available for the following:

- **Week of August 22 – mandatory orientation training will be held at each campus.**
- Campus guides (approximately 2 hours per day) the week classes begin
- Staffing welcome areas during the semester
- Various times/days throughout the semester for campus events

**Mandatory training meetings are held on Fridays.**
